REQUEST TO REVIEW THE MAKERERE UNIVERSITY STUDENTS GUILD CONSTITUTION AS AMMENDED 2016, MAKERERE UNIVERSITY STUDENT GUILD CONSTITUTION (ELECTIONS) REGULATIONS NO.1 OF 2018 AND THE MAKERERE UNIVERSITY GUIDELINES FOR CONDUCTING A BLEND OF ELECTRONIC AND PHYSICAL GUILD AND SENIOR COMMON ROOM (SCR) ELECTION DURING THE PERIOD OF COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

Following the just concluded Students Guild Elections, Management noted that the above Student Electoral Policies had a number of crisscrossing legal interpretation. Additionally it was also noted that the Guidelines supersede the Constitution.

Management further proposed that you begin the process of amending these laws to ensure successful implementation of the Guild elections for future guild elections.

The purpose of this letter, therefore, is to request you to start the process of amending the Student Guild Constitution, the Makerere University Guidelines for conducting a Blend of Electronic and Physical Guild and Senior Common Room (SCR) Elections during the period of the Covid-19 Pandemic Makerere University Student Guild Constitution (Elections) Regulations No.1 Of 2018.

The Management will expect a draft of your review by 30th April, 2022 and you are advised to work with the Directorate of Legal Affairs on this deliverable.
